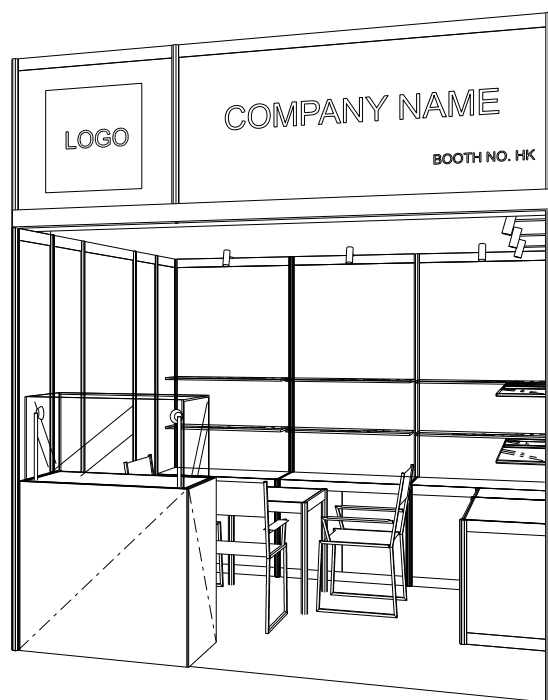

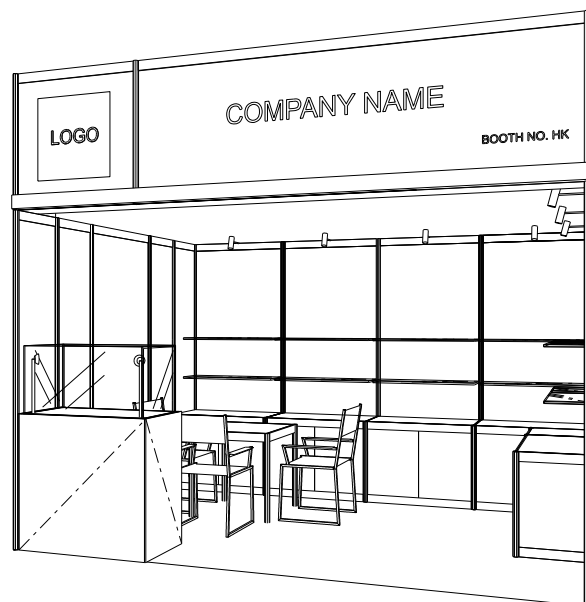

Definition

Eligibility for the Conditions of Participation

- 2.1 The Organisers have the sole and absolute discretion in relation to the admission of Exhibitors. Until an Exhibitor's application made by way of Application Form has been accepted in writing by the Organisers, no Exhibitor shall be permitted to exhibit at the Exhibition and the Organisers shall not be bound to deal with the application. The Organisers reserve the right to decline any application without giving any reason.
- 2.2 Exhibitors shall be responsible for the transportation of their exhibits to the Exhibition site from their country of origin in accordance with applicable laws. The Organisers may require Exhibitors to endorse with their Application Form or payment or other produce at any time a copy of their latest business registration certificate and a copy of their latest tax certificate. Exhibitors may also be required to provide product catalogues and/or other documents/materials as may be required by the Organisers proving that they are carrying on a bona fide business. Otherwise not otherwise notified by the Organisers, original documents and/or other documents/materials shall be submitted to the Organisers for their reference.
- 2.3 The Exhibitor warrants that the Application Form and all other documents and information submitted to the Organisers are true and correct and that the Exhibitor is not aware of any false or misleading information.
3. The use of the Exhibition Stand allocated to or custom built by the Exhibitor is strictly for trade promotion purpose only for the duration of the Exhibition. Exhibitor is required to use the area allocated for the Stand allocated to or custom built by the Exhibitor for trade promotion purpose only. Exhibitor shall not use the Stand for any other purpose. All booths must be properly managed, displayed and furnished with exhibits at all times during the Fair. Exhibitor shall comply with all applicable laws, regulations, license requirements and conditions in relation to the trade promotion purpose only. Exhibitor shall not use the Stand allocated to or custom built by the Exhibitor at Exhibitor's expense without notice and shall not be entitled to any way to claim for any loss or damage to the Stand allocated to or custom built by the Exhibitor. Exhibitor shall not be entitled to any claim for any refund in respect of the Booth Service Fee or for any other monies paid.

Payment

- 4.1 Where the Application Form is submitted in hard copy, the appropriate Booth Service Fee, which shall be non-refundable (save as provided in these Conditions), must accompany each application.
- 4.2 If the Applicant has submitted the Application Form electronically via the Exhibitor Online Platform, the appropriate Booth Service Fee, which shall be non-refundable (save as provided in these Conditions), must be submitted by the Exhibitor following the application, in accordance with any applicable terms and conditions relating to the payment of fees by exhibitors.
- 4.3 For the avoidance of doubt, neither any acknowledgement of the receipt of the Application Form nor any request for payment made or issued by the Organisers shall by any means constitute acceptance of the Application Form or any part thereof, until it has been approved by the Organiser. The responsibility for the Application Form should not be regarded as the final fee payable by the Exhibitor.
- The Booth Service Fee and all other monies payable to the Organisers are exclusive of all taxes. Any applicable tax shall be the responsibility of the Applicant. The Booth Service Fee will be used by the Organisers on behalf of the Exhibitor. If at any time there is any withholding or deduction in respect of any taxes, duties or other charges that the Exhibitor would need to apply in accordance with any applicable laws of any jurisdiction on any of the above, the Organiser shall ensure that the Exhibitor is notified in writing of such charges in advance so that the Exhibitor can make the external necessary to ensure that after making such deduction or withholding, the net amount paid to the Exhibitor shall be equal to the sum it would have received if no deduction or withholding had been applied, and the Organiser shall ensure that the Exhibitor is notified in writing of such charges in advance so that the authorities on its own account. Any invoice sent to the Exhibitor by the Organisers may include any applicable tax chargeable in accordance with the applicable laws.
5. In the event that the Applicant does not intend to attend the exhibition, non-interest bearing deposit(s) at any time as a guarantee for the cost of actual or potential damage.
6. In the event that an application for participating in the Exhibition is not accepted by the Organisers, the Booth Service Fee shall be returned to the Applicant within 30 days from the date of notice of rejection of the application.
7. In the event of withdrawal, for whatever reason, its Application before being rejected by itself if a rejection of its exhibition participation.
- Use of Online Services**
8. Subject to service availability and the consent of the Organisers, the Exhibitor may use online services provided by the Organisers including via the Exhibitor Online Platform by logging in with a user identification code and password and paying for services in accordance with applicable law. The Exhibitor shall be responsible for ensuring that the Organisers provide an online platform for the Exhibitor to handle its application for participation in the Exhibition. The Organisers shall in no circumstances be liable to the Exhibitor or any other person for any unauthorised access thereto or for any error, mistake, delay, loss or omission in transmissions made using the system or for any damage to the Exhibitor's equipment or data.
- 8.1 If the online services are available to the Exhibitor, the Exhibitor may change its Username and Password at any time, but such changes shall only be effective if accepted by the Organisers.
- 8.2 The Exhibitor shall ensure that the Exhibitor's Username and Password is kept its Username and Password confidential. At no time and under no circumstances shall the Exhibitor disclose its Username and/or Password to any other person.
- 8.3 The Exhibitor shall be responsible in full for any unauthorised disclosure of the Username and/or Password to any other person and shall bear all risks of the same being used by any unauthorised persons or for any unauthorised purposes.
- 8.4 In the event of disclosure of the Username or Password being disclosed to or coming into the possession or control of any unauthorised person, or of any unauthorised use of the Organisers' online services being made, the Exhibitor shall notify the Organisers immediately and, until the Organisers' actual receipt of such notification, the Exhibitor shall remain responsible for any unauthorised use of the Organisers' online services.

Stand Allocation

- The Organizers have the sole and absolute discretion in allotting the area in the Exhibition Venue for the positioning or construction of Stands and determining the location of such Stands. All decisions to such effect shall be final and binding on the Exhibitors.
- 9.2 Any Exhibitor who wishes to use a name on its Stand which is different to that submitted on its Application Form must submit notice of this change to the Organisers in writing at least three months prior to the commencement of the Exhibition. Such notice must be accompanied by:
- (a) documentation (in form and substance satisfactory to the Organisers) signed by a certified accountant or the company secretary (in the case of a registered limited liability company) to prove that only the named company is the sole shareholder of the Exhibitor;
 - (b) other documentation (in form and substance satisfactory to the Organisers) to show that the new company name belongs to a wholly-owned subsidiary of the applicant.
- 9.3 If an Exhibitor who is not a company does not inform the Organisers subsequently divides its business between two or more of its existing shareholders, the Organisers shall have the right to offer the right to exhibit as follows:
- (a) to the sole shareholder of the original applicant, who can exhibit under its own company name provided that it will be displaying the same category of products as the original applicant; and
 - (b) if the shareholding is divided evenly then the Organisers reserve the rights to terminate the agreement with the applicant and to allot the right to exhibit to the new company formed among themselves.
- Regarding the transfer of the right to exhibit to the Organisers is notified at least 3 months prior to the commencement of the Exhibition.
- 10.1 The Organisers have the right to prohibit and to use, on a non-exclusive basis, the Stand allocated to or constructed by the Exhibitor is personal to the Exhibitor and shall not be transferred, assigned, sub-contracted, licensed to or otherwise howsoever shared with any third party. Any Exhibitor who is found by the Organisers to have breached this condition shall be liable to the Organisers for the cost of the Stand and to remove its stand with a third party, will be obliged to immediately withdraw from the Exhibition, dismantle its Stand and remove its exhibits at its own expense.
- 10.2 The Organisers may, at their discretion, maintain a record of those Exhibitors who have breached clause 10.1 of the Conditions and may at its sole and absolute discretion refuse to allow these Exhibitors or any of their shareholders, parent, associate, affiliated, associated and/or subsidiary companies and/or any brands) which it is associated with, to be represented or may represent to participate in any of all future exhibitions, events or trade fairs organised by the Organisers.
- 10.3 In order to promote, or distribute, or display any business card, material or exhibit (promotional or otherwise) beyond the name, logo or other presence of any employee or representative of, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Exhibitor or a third party company for writing to the Organisers as a distributor, the Exhibitor, its Stand, the Exhibitor must submit notice in writing to the Organisers for permission at least three months prior to the commencement of the exhibition together with supporting documents showing the connection between the Exhibitor and the relevant third party. The Organisers shall have the right to refuse to grant such permission or discretion to determine whether to give such permission and in giving such permission, may stipulate such conditions as it deems fit. For the avoidance of doubt, the Exhibitor shall be deemed to have breached clause 10.3 if the Exhibitor does not submit such notice to the Organisers in writing at least three months prior to the third party's name or allow the presence of any person other than its employee without the prior permission of the Organisers or in violation of any condition imposed.
- 10.4 The Organisers shall have the sole and absolute discretion to prevent Exhibitors from having more than one stand at the Exhibition.
- 10.5 The Organisers have the right at its sole and absolute discretion to prevent two or more Exhibitors with a common ownership or partnership or other relationship or association from having more than one stand at the same product range at separate Stands, notwithstanding their application having been accepted.

Stand Construction

1. Stands and exhibits shall not exceed the maximum floor loading limit as follows:

2. Organisers reserve the right to alter or amend the above notice and at the Exhibitor's expense any Stand which differs from the submitted specification or any Stand that does not conform to the Organisers' required standard, rules and regulations. The Exhibitor shall have no claim against the Organisers or its agents for any extra cost of replacing its Stand to conform to the Organisers' required standard, rules and regulations or for any exhibitor who has opted for Custom-Built Participation may appoint either the official stand contractor or their own contractor to design and construct their Exhibition Stands, the design of which must be submitted to the Organisers for review and approval prior to construction.
3. The work of any kind carried out at the Exhibition Venue must conform to the current local laws and regulations in force in Hong Kong, including but not limited to the compliance with the compulsory requirement to take out and maintain a policy of employees' compensation insurance pursuant to Section 40 of the Employees' Compensation Ordinance (Cap. 282) and any other laws relating to the employment of staff by the Organisers, agents, contractors and subcontractors. The Organisers reserves the right to stop any work which contravenes with any of these laws and regulations and the Exhibitor shall have no claim against the Organisers or its agents in the event of any damages caused.
4. The suspension of Stands or lighting devices from the ceiling structure of the Exhibition Venue is not permitted. All lighting devices to be attached onto a lighting truss of no more than 1m height, with a minimum of 2.5m and a maximum of 6m ground clearance.
5. The removal and disposal of any signage, margin boards and other stand fittings will not be permitted unless prior approval in writing is obtained from the Organisers.
6. The removal and disposal of crates and stand fittings or materials are not covered by the Booth Service Fee and the Organisers will not be liable for any charges imposed by the Exhibition Venue or such other sum as the Organisers may reasonably determine.

Shell Booths

18. Shell Booths are provided by the Organisers's official contractor and are of a standard design. No variations in any kinds in whatever nature of the Shell Booth including but not limited to its fascia board, lettering and fittings, shall be allowed unless prior written approval is given by the Organisers.
19. No decoration, booth fitting or exhibit shall exceed 2.5m in height or the height of the Shell Booth, whichever is lower.

Custom-built Participation

- Custom-Built Participation Contractors'** information, construction drawings, site work deposit and a copy of valid public liability insurance should reach the Organisers for review at least eight weeks before the commencement of the Exhibition. Otherwise, a late charge of HK\$3,000 (US\$400) will be charged to the Exhibitor or its appointed contractor. The Organiser reserves the right to request additional information from Exhibitors regarding their stand design, including information such as floor plan, stage elevation, electrical fittings, carpeting, colours and materials to be used, moving exhibits, audio-visual equipment, weights and point loading of exhibits.
- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse to accept any stand design and no custom-built stand is permitted to be erected at the Exhibition Venue unless the contractors' information, construction drawings, lighting plan, site work deposit (including late charge, if applicable) and a copy of valid insurance policy have been received by the Organiser.
- All custom-built participation designs, stand materials used and its construction must conform to the rules and regulations of the Exhibition Venue and those of any public authority or department of the Hong Kong SAR Government.
- Exhibitors are required to provide adequate insurance cover against all risks of damage to the stand erected by the Exhibitor or its appointed contractor. All such work must be carried out according to the arrangements and within the time limits specified in these Conditions or otherwise by the Organisers.
- Please refer to the following sections for details of the stand building process. If the Exhibitor is advised to construct a stand with the Organisers before commencing any Stand design work. General guide summarized as follows:

- (1) The maximum booth height for all single-deck custom-built booths is 4m. The maximum height for double-decked booths is 5m.
- (2) Stands situated within ± 0.5m of the smoke curtain at Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre, the maximum allowable stand height is 2.5m or 3m (depends on the location). Please refer to the hall plan or ceiling diagram, if required.
- (3) Stands shall not be taller than 2m, nor be submitted upon completion of work for all custom-built stands exceeding 2.5m in height, using a hanging lightning truss, and/or as otherwise deemed required by the Organisers and/or the Exhibition Venue's Operator. The structural safety certificate shall be endorsed by an APRSB and should be submitted to the Organisers at least 15 days prior to the start of the exhibition. If the rule is not observed, the Organisers and/or the Exhibition Venue's Operator reserve(s) the rights to prohibit all access to the Stand and/or to modify or dismantle it. Exhibitors must accept full responsibility for the safety of the Stand, as the Construction Department does not have jurisdiction over the stand.
- (4) Stands and temporary structures at 4.5m in height or above; hanging lightning truss with equipment weighing more than 100kg or above; self-standing speakers and/or lighting towers at 2.5m in height or above; stages at 1500mm in height or above; and other structures exceeding 2.5m in height shall require a written approval letter issued by an APRSB will be required by government authorities as well as the Exhibition Venue's operator. - For the purpose of the Exhibition, Exhibitors must ensure that the Exhibition Venue, please refer to the Exhibitors' Manual with which all Exhibitors and/or their appointed contractors are required to comply.

Electricity & Utility Services

- Only electricity can be used as a source of light or power at the Exhibition Venue.
- All electrical works shall be carried out at Exhibitor's expense by the official contractor appointed by the Organisers. The Organiser's plan or proposals for electrical works must be submitted to the Organisers for review not later than 6 weeks before the opening ceremony of the Exhibition. The Organisers may require amendments or variations to be made to the design plan or proposals at its sole and absolute discretion.
- Electric current will be supplied in 210-230 volt, single phase. Electric current of a higher voltage, (380 volts three phases), will be supplied subject to prior arrangement with the Organisers. The maximum electric power available is 20 KW per 15 square meter of floor area.
- The electricity, whether from the main, batteries or generators shall be supplied only through the Exhibition Venue's official contractor.
- Utility services such as electricity, compressed air, water, drainage, may be supplied only by venue provider. Outside supplier and self-brought equipment is strictly prohibited. If require such service, please contact the Organisers.

Use of Stand & Safety

Exhibitors' Brief on the Protection of Intellectual Property Rights at HKCTCE Exhibitions ("Exhibitors' Brief") that the Organisers may issue from time to time, including abiding by any complaint procedures and penalties stated in the Exhibitors' Brief, whether as a complainant or as a respondent in any such complaint procedure. The Organisers shall have the sole and exclusive authority to decide to abide by any of the terms and conditions of the Exhibitors' Brief, the Organisers shall have the sole and absolute discretion to ban the Exhibitor and any or all of its shareholders and/or parent, associate, affiliated, subsidiary, agent, contractor or employee and any brand name or vehicle that is represented, represented by, or represented from from any of all future exhibitions, events or trade fairs organised by the Organisers and/or to further ban any representatives of the Exhibitor in question from entering the venue of the current Exhibition in which the Exhibitor is participating.
- 4.3 If a complainant Exhibitor ("complainant") files a complaint with the Organisers in accordance with the Exhibitors' Brief and requests the Organisers to take action against an Exhibitor, the complainant agrees to hold the Organisers harmless and to fully indemnify each and every one of them against any and all liabilities, losses, costs (including but not limited to legal costs), expenses and damages of any nature whatsoever incurred or suffered by any only claimant or any other person or entity, including the Organisers, in connection with the complaint procedure, whether or not the complainant or employees (including but not limited to their legal advisors) may be taken in reliance of or as result of such complaint filed by the complainant, or any other requests, directions or instructions made or given by the complainant or employees (including but not limited to their legal advisors) to take any legal action or make any claim or demand against the Organisers, its agents, representative, contractors or employees (including but not limited to their legal advisors) in relation to such complaint and the alleged infringement of intellectual property rights.
- 4.4 The Organisers shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by the Exhibitor or its employees, contractors or employees and must in any case be completed by 6pm on the day immediately preceding the commencement date of the Exhibition. The Organisers reserve the right to assemble, install or decorate any area in the Exhibition Venue for the Exhibition. The Organisers, its contractors, employees and/or vendors may, at any time at the Organisers' expense, remove any Exhibitor's display from the Exhibition Venue.
- 4.5 Any kind of repairs or alterations in whatever nature to the Stand or displays may only be carried out after the Exhibition has commenced and must be completed before the start of the Exhibition.
- 4.6 No Stand or exhibits shall be dismantled or removed before the official closing time of the Exhibition on the last day of Exhibition unless special permission has been given by the Organisers.
- 4.7 The Organisers shall not be liable for any loss or damage suffered by the Exhibitor or its employees, contractors or to other Exhibitors or visitors. The Organisers reserve the right to appoint any or more exclusive audio-visual equipment suppliers whereupon the Exhibitor shall be obliged to hire the equipment of such exclusive suppliers and to pay for the equipment and the services of such suppliers. The Organisers' selection and broadcasting at the Exhibition Venue unless prior written approval is obtained from the Organisers.
- 4.8 Any public auctions, illegal gambling or unauthorised Trade Promotion Competitions shall not be permitted on or within the Exhibition Venue.
- 4.9 All full particulars of all personnel, agents or representatives of the Exhibitor must be submitted to the Organisers for approval and registration before they may be admitted to the Exhibition Venue. All such personnel, agents or representatives of the Exhibitor must be issued with identification badges by the Organisers and must wear such identification badges at all times while at the Exhibition with badges for identification and admission purposes, and such badges are non-transferable. The Exhibitor must follow the proper procedures prescribed by the Organisers should they need to apply for additional badges. No personnel or representatives of the Exhibitor shall be permitted to enter the Exhibition Venue without badges and that the Organisers owns all intellectual property rights in the badges. The Exhibitor hereby undertakes to procure and also warrants that it and all its authorised personnel shall:
- (a) not display the badges conspicuously while at the Exhibition Venue;
 - (b) not to make any unauthorised copies of or otherwise reproduce any badge ("Unauthorised Badge"), or to make any unauthorised copies of or otherwise reproduce any Unauthorised Badge, or to make any unauthorised copies of or otherwise reproduce any Unauthorised Badge, or to make any unauthorised copies of or otherwise reproduce any Unauthorised Badge;
 - (c) not pass or transfer their badges to any other person;
 - (d) return their badges to the Organisers at the conclusion of the Exhibition upon demand by the Organisers;
 - (e) not use the badges for any other purpose;
 - (f) comply with all obligations imposed on them as the condition of approval of their admission to the Exhibition by the Organisers.
- Should the Organisers find any unauthorised or inappropriate use of badges by any person, the Organisers shall have the right at its sole and absolute discretion to take any or all of the following actions:
- (a) immediately confiscate such badges and refuse entry of the Exhibition Venue to such person(s);
 - (b) require the Exhibitor to pay for the badges, charge additional fees for the Organisers to recover the cost of issuing additional badges for the Exhibitor;

 - (d) require the Exhibitor to pay for the badges and to pay for the Organisers to recover the cost of issuing additional badges for the Exhibitor, postponing the Exhibitor's turn to select its booth location for the fair to be held in the following year, or to ban the Exhibitor from exhibiting at the Fair or any other future exhibition by the Organisers.
- 4.10 The Exhibitor shall be responsible for the cost of the Unauthorised Badge and shall be liable to pay any further legal actions against the Exhibitor for the unauthorised use or inappropriate use of the badge.

Publicity

51. The Organisers shall arrange and be responsible for all publicity arrangements for the Exhibition both overseas and in Hong Kong and no Exhibitor, or its agents, shall give or cause to be given any interview, public announcement, press statement, or any other publicity whatsoever intended to publicize the Exhibition as a whole.
52. The Exhibitor shall not disclose, appropriate or use and shall prevent its representative at the Exhibition from disclosing, appropriating or using any technical or confidential information regarding the business or affairs of the Organisers or

any of the Exhibitors at the Exhibition acquired by way of the Exhibitor's license to exhibit at the Exhibition.

- Move-in and Move-out of Stand Materials / Publicity Material & Exhibits**
53. Exhibitor shall move in to the Exhibition Venue according to the arrangements and within the time limits specified by the Organisers.
54. Subject to Clause 58 below, the arrangement and payment for transporting goods, products or exhibits to and from the Exhibition Venue, and the receiving, decorating and removing its goods, products or exhibits are the responsibility of the Exhibitor.
55. No trailers shall be allowed in any carpeted areas of the Exhibition Venue.
56. The Organisers shall have the right to remove any goods or exhibits of the Advertiser/Exhibitor shall be removed by the relevant Exhibitor according to the arrangements and within the time limits specified by the Organisers. Any goods, products, exhibits or Stand material/Publicity Materials and the like of the Advertiser/Exhibitor which are not removed by the relevant Exhibitor shall be deemed to have been abandoned and the Advertiser/Exhibitor shall be treated as absolutely and forever waive all rights and claims in respect of those goods, products, exhibits or Stand material/Publicity Materials and the like against the Organisers.
57. The Organisers shall have the right to remove any goods or exhibits of the Advertiser/Exhibitor which are not removed by the relevant Exhibitor according to the arrangements and within the time limits specified by the Organisers. Any goods, products, exhibits or Stand material/Publicity Materials at the Organiser's absolute discretion without further notice to the Advertiser/Exhibitor. The Organiser's rights in Clause 56 shall survive the conclusion of the Exhibition or the termination of the agreement between the Organisers and the Advertiser/Exhibitor. Any goods or exhibits of the Advertiser/Exhibitor which are not removed by the relevant Exhibitor shall be deemed to have been abandoned and the Advertiser/Exhibitor shall be treated as absolutely and forever waive all rights and claims in respect of those goods, products, exhibits or Stand material/Publicity Materials and the like against the Organisers.
58. The Organisers reserve the right to appoint one or more exclusive contractor(s) to handle the movements of all goods and exhibits in and out of the Exhibition Venue, whereupon the Exhibitor shall be obliged to hire the contractor(s) to handle the movements of all goods and exhibits in and out of the Exhibition Venue.

Links to Exhibitor's Web Site

58. The Exhibitor's Web site should:
- (a) be professionally prepared, organised and maintained in a presentable and respectable manner, compatible with the quality of the image of the Organisers;
 - (b) contain information aimed at promoting trade and business, and should be in compliance with all applicable laws;
 - (c) not be a mail order catalogue for products or services; and retail operations are not permitted for function through text made available through the Organisers' Web site;
 - (d) not be a database or contain any link to other Web sites.
59. The Exhibitor agrees to and welcomes the Organiser's establishment and provision of a hyperlink link to the Exhibitor's Web site on the Organiser's Web site for such duration as the Organiser in its sole and absolute discretion may deem fit. The Exhibitor agrees that the Organiser shall not be liable for any loss or liability whatsoever arising from or in connection with the Organiser's provision or removal of the hyperlink link or any service interruptions of the Organiser's Web site, whether caused by the Organiser or its employees or not.
60. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any of the following:
- (a) critical, defamatory, libellous, slanderous or derogatory messages, statements or material about other countries, territories, governments, cultures, religions, persons, companies, Organisations, entities, products, services or otherwise;
 - (b) obscene or indecent articles;
 - (c) messages, statements or material which may be considered violent, racist, harmful or otherwise objectionable in nature or any information or displays, pictures or captured photos or filmclips which may or may not become subject to the Hong Kong National Security Law, Safeguarding National Security Ordinance and related laws and regulations;
 - (d) any information or material which is deceiving, misleading or likely to cause confusion to site visitors;
 - (e) any information or material which is illegal in the Exhibitor's country, the country its website is hosted in, or

Exhibitor's Undertakings

61. The Exhibitor hereby undertakes to the Organisers that it shall:
 - (a) take all necessary precautions to ensure that:
 - (i) the information or material on the Exhibitor's Web site is at all relevant time accurate, truthful and complete;
 - (ii) the Exhibitor's Web site is virus free and that it shall inform the Organisers immediately of any infection or compromise of its hardware or material on its Web site of any kind or virus;
 - (iii) regularly update its Web site to maintain accuracy and to ensure conformity with the established image and the reputation of the Organisers;
 - (b) inform the Organisers of any changes made to the name of a web page on the Exhibitor's Web site or its home page; and
 - (c) ensure that the content of its Web site:
 - (i) do not infringe any intellectual property rights or other rights of any third party;
 - (ii) must not at any time violate any laws applicable to the Exhibitor or the Organisers, including but not limited to any Hong Kong or other applicable laws, rules or regulations applicable to the Internet or its usage, and other applicable laws; and
 - (iii) conform to the reasonable opinion of the Organisers, unfavourable to the image of the Organisers or otherwise undesirable.
62. Where the Exhibitor is using online services provided by the Organisers and has registered for those services and uses any such services, the Exhibitor's Online Platform shall not allow any person other than those authorised to act on its behalf to use such online services, and it shall not allow any person to use any services or to register for any such services for any unauthorised or illegal purpose or activity. The Exhibitor shall notify the Organisers as soon as practicable if it becomes aware of such use.
63. The Organisers reserve the right at any time to bar access to or delete the link between the Organisers' Web site and the Exhibitor's web site at the Organisers' sole and absolute discretion without notice and without giving any reasons therefor.
64. The Exhibitor irrevocably warrants all rights to bring any claim or action against the Organisers for any loss, damage or injury suffered by the Exhibitor or its visitors, which the Exhibitor has deposited with the Organisers, accessible from the Organisers's Web site.
65. The Exhibitor shall be held liable for any and/or all illegal or unauthorised use of materials from the Organisers's Web site or other infringement conducts of any visitors to the Exhibitor's Web site via the link on the Organisers's Web site.
66. The Exhibitor undertakes to fully indemnify and at all time to keep indemnified in full the Organisers from and against all losses, liabilities, actions, proceedings, claims, damages, costs (including but not limited to legal costs) and expenses whatsoever and wherever arising which the Organisers may suffer or incur by reason of or in connection with the use of the Organisers's Web site.

Exclusion of Liability

Waiver

75. The waiver by the Organisers of any of these Conditions shall not prevent the subsequent enforcement of these Conditions and shall not be deemed to act as a waiver in respect of any subsequent breach.

Termination of Right to Exhibit

- The Organisers shall have the right to terminate without notice an Exhibitor's right to exhibit in the Exhibition and shall have the sole and absolute discretion to ban the Exhibitor and/or any one of its shareholders, parent, subsidiary, agent, representative, employee, director, officer, partner, associate, consultant, contractor, subcontractor, agent, representative or any other person who is associated with the Exhibitor, or any of them, if the Exhibitor or any of them, or its representatives or any of them, fails to comply with the following conditions:
- (a) if an Exhibitor or any of its representatives commits a breach of any of the Conditions or any additional conditions set out in the Exhibitor's contract with the Organisers;
 - (b) if an Exhibitor, being a body corporate, enters into a liquidation whether compulsory or voluntarily or compounds with its creditors or has a receiver appointed over all or any part of its assets or fails or suffers its affairs to be wound up or is declared bankrupt or insolvent or is made bankrupt or insolvent or becomes, or one of its members becomes bankrupt or insolvent or enters into any arrangements with its creditors or is taken over or sold or its assets are sold or its business is sold or its shares are sold;
 - (c) if the Exhibitor conducts any activity which, in the opinion of the Organisers, does not conform to the nature and purpose of the Exhibition, or interferes with the rights of other Exhibitors at the Exhibition; or if the Exhibitor or any of its representatives does anything which is likely to bring the Exhibition (or the purpose of the Exhibition) to private persons or sells goods for immediate delivery in the Exhibition Venue; or
 - (d) if the Stand is not occupied by the Exhibitor 30 minutes before the opening hour (as published in the Organisers' Manual produced by the Organisers) on the first exhibition day of the Exhibition, the Exhibitor shall be deemed to have withdrawn from the Exhibition, and the Organisers shall have the right to use the space allocated to the Exhibitor for other purposes. If the Exhibitor fails to occupy the Stand, the Service Fee paid will be forfeited as if the Exhibitor had cancelled the participation as of such date; or
 - (e) if the Exhibitor displays on its stand or in its display area any product or service which is not the appropriate products or services in the product category zone as stated in the information letter of the Exhibitor or incorporates any product which does not correspond to the product listing as stated in the Exhibitor's Form of Application.
 - (f) if the Exhibitor is found to be acting in a discriminatory manner against certain visitors at the Exhibitions; or
 - (g) if the Exhibitor is found to have committed any act which, in the opinion of the Organisers, might prejudice the reputation of the Organisers or the Exhibition, or if the Exhibitor is found to be in breach of any law of concern indeed but not limited to Hong Kong National Security Law, Safeguarding National Security Ordinance, product safety and regulation for intellectual property rights (IPR), labour rights, environmental protection and other applicable laws.
 - (h) if the Exhibitor is accused or convicted of any criminal offence or otherwise so conducts itself as to bring itself, the Exhibition or the Organisers into disrepute, or
 - (i) if the Exhibitor is in breach of any applicable laws, rules or regulations, including contrary to Hong Kong laws.

77. In the event that an Exhibitor's right to exhibit in the Exhibition is terminated under clause 77 (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j) or (l) of the Conditions, the Exhibitor shall have no claim for refund of any monies paid to the Organisers.
78. The Organisers shall return to the Exhibitor all Booth Service Fees paid in the event of a termination of the Exhibitor's right to exhibit under clause 76 (k) of the Conditions. The Exhibitor shall have no other claims against the Organisers for any of its loss or damages in connection with any such termination.

Postponement and Cancellation of Exhibition

79. The Organisers reserve the right to change the date(s) of the Exhibition to other date(s) (including but not limited to postponing to later date(s)) as the Organisers deems fit, or cancel, alter in character or mode, reduce in scale, shorten or extend the duration of the Exhibition at any time without incurring any liability whatsoever to the Exhibitor due to circumstances beyond the Organisers's control including but not limited to acts of God, war, health concerns (such as outbreaks of the Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome, bird flu or other health threats), fear of terrorist attack, riots, demonstrations, travel restrictions, curfew, epidemic, embargo, civil unrest, legal proceedings, industrial disputes of whatever nature, government regulations, the lack of or refusal to grant any government or third party approvals, permits, consents or licences, major disruption of transport system, system malfunctions or failure of telecommunications or other electronic communications that make it in the opinion of the Organisers impossible or impractical or undesirable for the Organisers to hold the Exhibition as initially planned. The Exhibitor shall have no claim against the Organisers or its agents or representatives, whether for loss or damage, or return of all or part of any money paid by the Exhibitor in respect of any postponement, cancellation, alteration, reduction, shortening or extension made in accordance with this provision.
80. The Organisers reserve the right to change the plan, site character or venue of the Exhibition at any time without giving notice to the Exhibitor. Proportional allowance for use of the Exhibition Venue may be made if deemed appropriate by the Organisers (in its sole and absolute discretion) but it shall not be liable for any further compensation to the Exhibitor.

Disclaimer

81. The Organisers have the sole and absolute discretion in relation to the admission of visitors to the Exhibition (including but not limited to determining any admission requirements or procedures). The Exhibitor acknowledges that the Organisers have given no commitment or guarantee as regards the number of visitors to the Exhibition and the results of the Exhibition and agrees that it has no claim against the Organisers or its agents or representatives in this connection.
82. The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that the Organisers shall not be responsible for any losses or damages that the Exhibitor's business may suffer and that the Organisers has made no warranties of any kind, express or implied for services to be provided hereunder. The Organisers hereby disclaims any warranty or merchantability or fitness for any particular purpose.
83. The Exhibitor further acknowledges and agrees that the Organisers shall not be responsible for any system malfunctions or failure of telecommunications or other electronic communications at the Exhibition Venue which is beyond the Organisers's control.

Additional Rules & Regulations

84. The Organisers reserve the right to interpret, alter and amend any of these Conditions and to issue additional rules and regulations (including but not limited to the exhibitors' manual) at any time it considers necessary for the orderly operation of the Exhibition. The amended Conditions and the additional rules and regulations shall become effective immediately upon posting of the same on our website at www.hktdc.com/hktrdefairs. Once the amended Conditions and the additional rules and regulations have been posted on our website at www.hktdc.com/hktrdefairs, you will be deemed to have notice of the same and have accepted the amended Conditions and the additional rules and regulations. All interpretations of these Conditions and any additional rules and regulations by the Organisers shall be final and binding on the Exhibitor.
85. The Exhibitor shall abide by the rules and regulations of the Exhibition Venue which are deemed to be integral parts of and incorporated into these Conditions. In the event of conflict between the provisions of such rules and regulations and these Conditions, these Conditions shall prevail. Copies of the rules and regulations of the Exhibition Venue are available from the Organisers on request. For details, please refer to <https://www.hkcec.com/en/house-rules>.
86. The Exhibitor is responsible for all its own costs and charges incurred in entering into and carrying out the agreement governed by these Conditions, including any and all costs associated with communications facilities and access to electronic services.

Notices

87. All notices, agreements, approvals, permissions and the like required by these Conditions to be in writing must be given:

 - or by such other methods as agreed or as notified by the Organisers from time to time. The Exhibitor consents to the use of electronic records and communications and online processing for all matters connected to these Conditions or their subject matter.

Conflict with Application Form

88. If the provisions of these Conditions conflict with the Application Form, the provisions of these Conditions shall prevail.

Language

89. These Conditions are prepared in both English and Chinese languages. In the event of any discrepancy between the two language versions, the English version shall prevail.

Governing Law

90. These Conditions shall be governed by and construed in all respects in accordance with the laws of Hong Kong and the Exhibitor irrevocably submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Hong Kong courts.
